SECONDARY (HIGH SCHOOL) ACADEMIC RECORDS

1. Study for a minimum of two (2) years at a U.S. high school with grades of C or better in academic English (not ESL)
2. Final IGCSE or O level results with a grade of C or higher in one of the following: English Language, English – First Language, English as a Second Language
3. Graduation from a high school outside the U.S. where English is the primary language of instruction. Provide a letter from a school official on institution letterhead stating that English is the medium of instruction.

POST-SECONDARY (COLLEGE / UNIVERSITY) ACADEMIC RECORDS

Transcripts from U.S. institutions showing one (1) academic year of college level English with grades of C or better.
